

## Be Going To

We use **Be going to** to talk about **plans, intentions and predictions.**  
Things that are going to happen **in the future.**

**Subject + verb TO BE + GOING TO + verb**

**I am going to study** tonight.



I **'m (am) going to study** English tonight.  
You **'re (are) going to study** English tonight.  
He **'s (is) going to study** English tonight.  
She **'s (is) going to study** English tonight.  
It **'s (is) going to study** English tonight.  
We **'re (are) going to study** English tonight.  
They **'re (are) going to study** English tonight.

I **'m not going to study** English tonight.  
You **aren't going to study** English tonight.  
He **isn't going to study** English tonight.  
She **isn't going to study** English tonight.  
It **isn't going to study** English tonight.  
We **aren't going to study** English tonight.  
They **aren't going to study** English tonight.

**Am I going to study** English tonight?

Yes, you are. / No, you aren't.

**Are you going to study** English tonight?

Yes, I am. / No, I'm not.

**Is he going to study** English tonight? Yes, he is. / No, he isn't.

**Is she going to study** English tonight? Yes, she is. / No, she isn't.

**Is it going to study** English tonight? Yes, it is. / No, it isn't.

**Are we going to study** English tonight? Yes, we are. / No, we aren't.

**Are they going to study** English tonight? Yes, they are. / No, they aren't.

## 1. Plans or intentions

We use it when we have already decided to do something.

It is **a plan for the future.**

I am **going to start** a new course.

She is **going to visit** her parents tomorrow.



## 2. Predictions based on evidence

when we see **something that indicates something will happen.**

Look at those clouds!

It is **going to rain.**

He is driving too fast.

He is **going to have** an accident.
